At Sand Point, we think nature has its place – and that place is in and around our vineyards. We’ve restored the riparian habitat where our ranch meets the Mokelumne River – including the spot that gave Sand Point its name. Since then, we’ve brought nearby sloughs back into natural balance and surrounded our vineyards with 15-foot-wide swaths of native plants and trees, inviting bugs, birds and animals to make themselves at home. In return, the healthy soil and water nourishes our vines. Wild? Yes... but to us, it’s following in nature’s footsteps.



TASTING NOTE

Dense ripe strawberry and cherry cola aromas and flavors are the core of our fruit-forward 2017 Pinot Noir. With French Oak aging for one year, there is a hint of autumn spice that melds into the opening notes, creating a smooth and balanced wine that is easy to enjoy.
